

Dear Ms Smith,

Thank you for your enquiry about Teach Outdoors Survival Sessions. Please find below examples of typical activities that could be included in the sessions. These activities are examples only and can be changed to meet any specific needs, themes or requests you have.

○ Den Building Activity Examples

Simple dens – children are provided with rope and tarpaulins to create their own shelter between trees.

Different types of shelters – children are shown tepees, bivouacs and tarpaulin shelters. They look at the features of each design and then build their own.

○ Fire Activity Examples

Making fire – children have a go at using a flint to make a spark and produce a flame.

Campfire – children can watch and learn how to build a larger fire and then enjoy toasting marshmallows and making hot chocolate.

Cooking – children cook popcorn or cookie dough over the fire.

Pewter Castings – children design their own clay moulds and use molten pewter to make their master piece.

○ Craft Activity Examples

Clay jewellery – children are given the opportunity to find a suitably sized ‘pokey stick’ that they can whittle to form a point using a vegetable peeler. Using clay they form their own jewellery bead shapes, then use their sticks to add holes before threading onto string.

Wooden cars – children are provided with tools such as bow saws and hammers to cut their own logs and produce a wooden vehicle. The vehicles can be painted and decorated before a race finishes off the activity.

Stick characters – children choose their sticks and bind them together with string. After finding natural materials such as leaves they decorate the sticks to make hands, faces etc. The final touches can be added with paint and googly eyes.

The number of activities completed in a session would depend on the allocated time, organisation, age range and number of participants. This would need to be discussed in more detail.
